Requirements to Establish Registration in the ACT (for vehicles equal to or less than 10 years old)

Please read the following information carefully to ascertain what you are required to do when registering your vehicle.

In **addition** to the requirements of the table below you must present your vehicle to the Dickson Test Station for a Vehicle Identity Check **if**;

- The vehicle is from interstate or not currently registered and being registered in a different name (a vehicle identity check is not required if the vehicle is purchased from a Licensed Motor Vehicle Dealer or Auction House [e.g. Pickles or Fowles]). If the vehicle was purchased through on-line auctioneers such as eBay, an ID check will be required unless the seller has a licence to operate as a licensed dealer in which case no ID check is required.
 In all cases the tax invoice must display the seller's licence number (e.g. LMVD, LVD, MD, LMCT etc).
- Written off - for repairable written off vehicles.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **You should book an Identity Check as soon as possible as there can be a waiting list.**
- **Registration plates for interstate or ACT vehicles must be surrendered upon establishment of registration.**
- **A passed roadworthy inspection report is required before an Identity Check can be conducted.**

Vehicle Inspection Bookings are essential List of Authorised Inspection Stations are available on request	A passed roadworthy inspection report is required from an ACT authorised inspection station. The inspection report is valid for one month from the date of the initial inspection. If the vehicle fails, the required work must be completed and the vehicle re-inspected at the same authorised station.
LPG Conversion	If your vehicle runs on LPG, you must obtain a Gas Inspection Certificate from an ACT Authorised Inspector before the vehicle is inspected.

Proof of Purchase or Acquisition (whichever is applicable)	Interstate registration certificate in your name. Interstate registration certificate signed by former operators stating the new operator's details. Receipt signed by previous operators showing purchase price and details of vehicle. Bill of Sale.
Proof of Identity Handout available on request	Current ACT or interstate photographic driver licence or full proof of identity.
Proof of Garaging	Current ACT photographic driver licence. Rates, electricity or telephone account. Tenancy agreement (not rent receipt).

Plates	All interstate plates MUST be surrendered upon establishment of registration.

Please Note: The minimum age requirements for registered operators are as follows:
 Heavy Vehicles 18 years Motorbikes 16 years and 9 months
 Light Vehicles 16 years
