LANGUAGE SKILLS ASSESSMENT FOR TAXI DRIVERS (LSATD)

INTRODUCTION

The Language Skills Assessment for Taxi Drivers (LSATD) has been introduced in the ACT to ensure that taxi driver recruits meet the minimum national English language skill standards required by the regulatory authorities. The test is conducted by the CIT Vocational College at the Canberra Institute of Technology.

TEST PROCEDURES

One **written paper 75 minutes**. Candidates will be asked to:

- **Listen** to several short extracts and answer questions.
- **Read** several short texts about topics relevant to taxi drivers and answer a number of questions.
- **Write** a short letter and/or report about a topic or topics related to the work of taxi drivers.

One **structured interview 10 – 12 minutes** to assess speaking skills. Candidates will be asked to:

- **Discuss** a number of general topics
- **Talk** about a topic provided by the assessor
- **Discuss** a given topic in more detail

Interviews are scheduled after the written paper. Candidates will be required to wait in a supervised waiting room after the written test for their interview. Candidate interviews will be recorded for formal assessment purposes.

HOW TO APPLY AND PAY

- Complete an application form and take it to the CIT Vocational College Office (Room J02, CIT Reid Campus, Constitution Avenue, Reid) for registration and confirmation of test session details
- Take the completed, authorised application form to the CIT Student Services Hub, Reid Campus to finalise enrolment and pay the test fee of \$240. This can be done during working hours. You will need to bring your drivers' licence and Medicare card with you.
- You can pay by cash, credit card, EFTPOS or cheque.
- **Please note:** enrolment **MUST** be completed by close of business at least 5 working days before the test date and payment is required at the time of enrolment.

TEST DATES

Fourth Friday of each month. Additional test dates may be arranged to meet demand if needed.

TEST DAY

- Registration for the test will be between 12noon and 1.15pm in Room J02 Reid Campus
- Candidates must bring their enrolment form and photo ID (passport or drivers' licence).
- Candidates who arrive late will not be permitted to take the test. No refunds will be issued to late arrivals.
