



Notice of Disposal

In the event that you are selling or disposing of your vehicle and have misplaced your 'Notice of Disposal' (back of Certificate of Registration) print this form, complete it and return it to the Road Transport Authority, PO Box 582, Dickson ACT 2602.

Please note that where a vehicle is registered in two names, both signatures **must** appear in the Disposer's Signatures section. In the event a vehicle is registered in a company name, it is necessary for the person signing on behalf of the company to demonstrate his/her authority to dispose of the vehicle on behalf of the company.

Do not rely on a new owner or dealer to transfer the registration into their name.

You will be held liable for parking fines and any other traffic offences until the owner's details are recorded by the Road Transport Authority. You should keep a copy of the completed Notice of Disposal for your own
